Any Imbalance Causes Pain is a series that examines dialogue as a structural element of human relationships. Based on the understanding that every bond is sustained within an unstable field of negotiation and listening, the work approaches communication as a zone of ongoing tension between closeness and interference.

The photographs visually construct this fragile line between balance and rupture. Bodies, gestures, and distances become metaphors for relationships shaped by gaps, silences, and misalignments. Imbalance does not appear solely as explicit conflict, but as subtle displacement, a slight misalignment capable of destabilizing the encounter.

The series understands relational fragility as a universal condition. Rather than offering solutions, the images reveal the instability that underlies any attempt at connection. The relationship is presented as continuous movement, an ongoing process of adjustment between presence, attention, and vulnerability.

By emphasizing this state of tension, *Any Imbalance Causes Pain* shifts the focus away from idealized harmony toward the effort required to sustain a bond. The work frames communication as an active and unfinished practice, a constant exercise in the face of potential separation.
